### Elements and Principles Assignment

Make sure you have one great photo for each of the following bullets:

#### Elements of Art:

- Color
- Form/Shape
- Line
- Space
- Texture
- Value

#### Principles of Design:

- Balance
- Contrast
- Emphasis
- Movement/Rhythm
- Pattern
- Proportion



#### Check list for your layout:

- Have the title "Elements of Art" and "Principles of Design"
- Make sure your name is clear on each layout
- Be creative in the manner that you organize your photographs
- Place the element of principle name next to the chosen photo, either at the top, below, or on either side

#### Saving:

Each student will create a folder on their desktop titled "Elements-Principles" this is where each photo will be saved. To ensure that each project is backed up the students will also be asked to save it to their jump drive (given to them by me) in order for me to print off each project. Each photo should be saved as a **jpeg!!!!**

#### Organizing:

Then each of these photos will be put into an InDesign document and should be arranged nicely to allow each photo to express the work you have captured. Before each photo is placed into the InDesign document, it should be put through Photoshop in order to make sure each photo is crisp and clean.

**Grade:**

- Each student will be graded based on the quality of each photograph as well as how distinct each element or principle is captured.
- There should be a clear focal point or point of interest in each photo and the photo should never be blurry!
- There should also be strong darks and strong lights.
- Also if the final project is not saved appropriately it will not be graded and will unfortunately result in a low grade.
